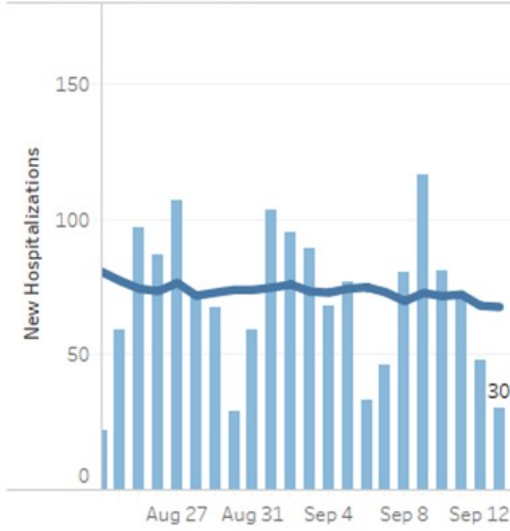

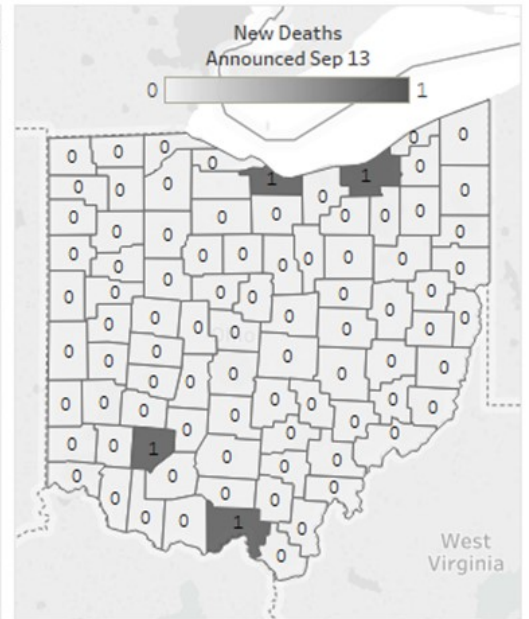
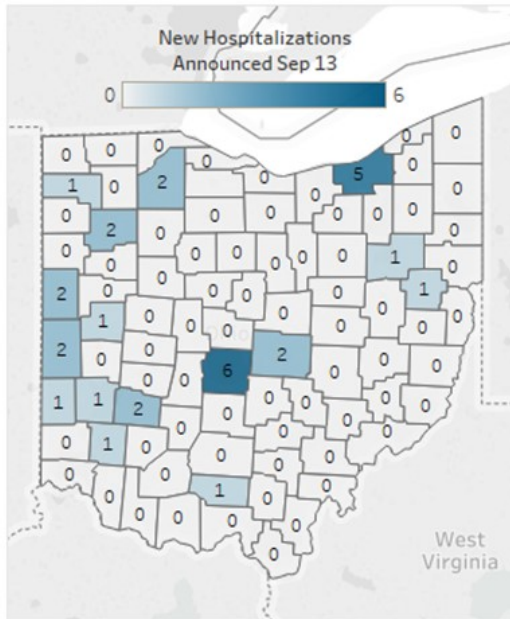
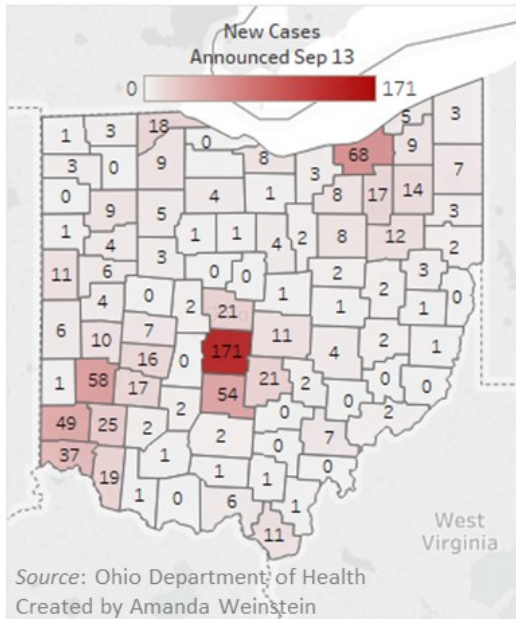
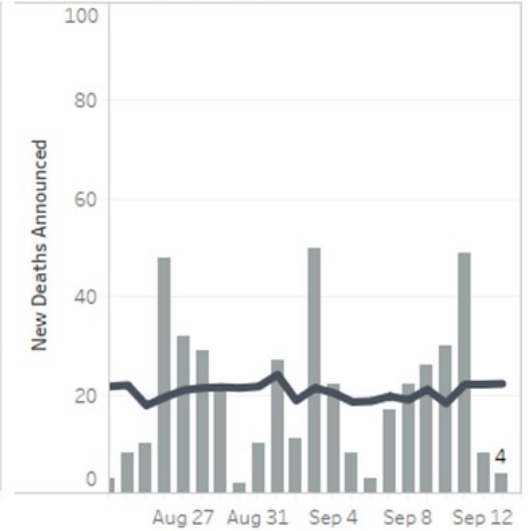
■ 7-Day Average of New Cases

■ New Hospitalizations

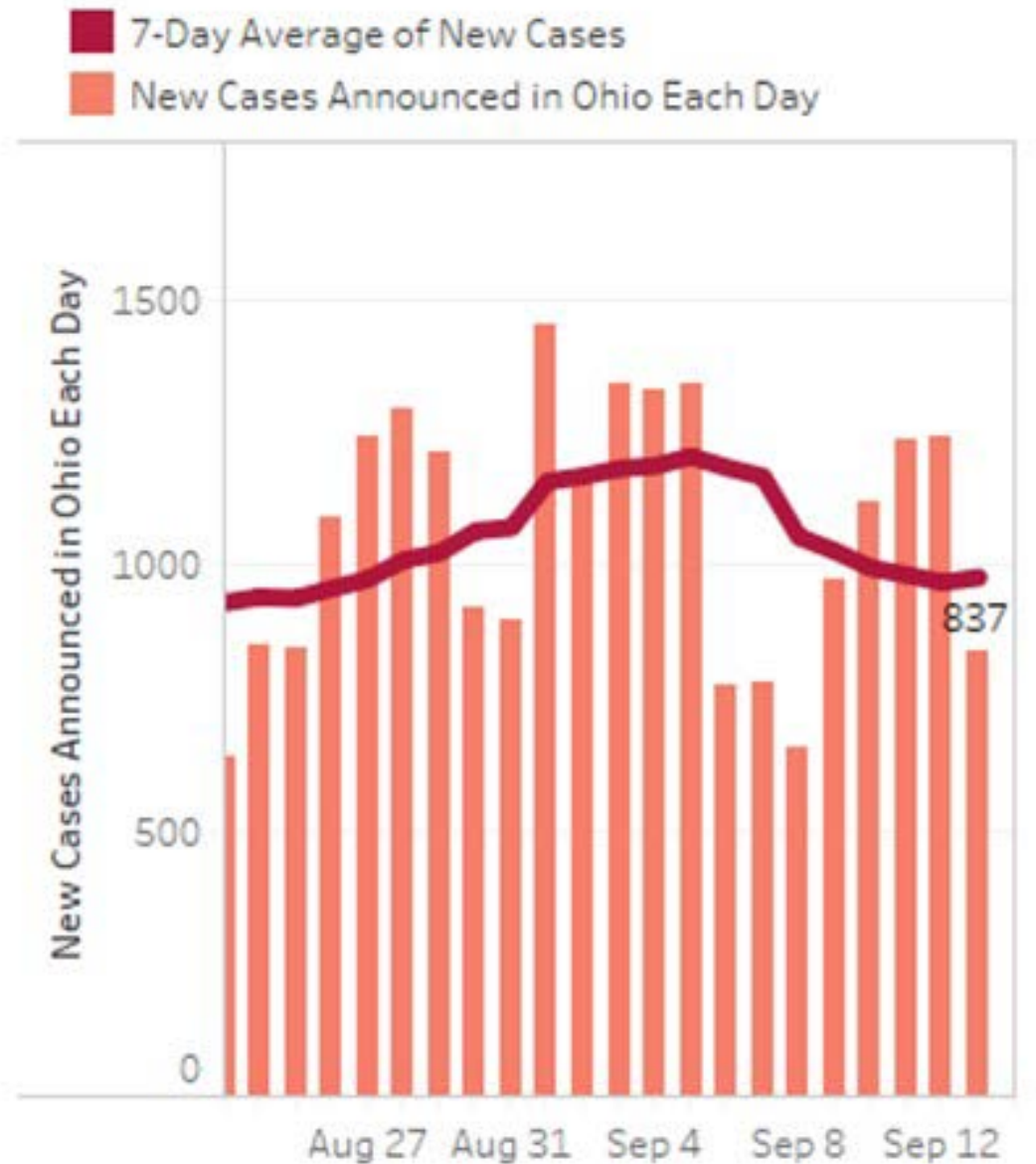


■ 7-Day Average of New Deaths
■ New Deaths Announced



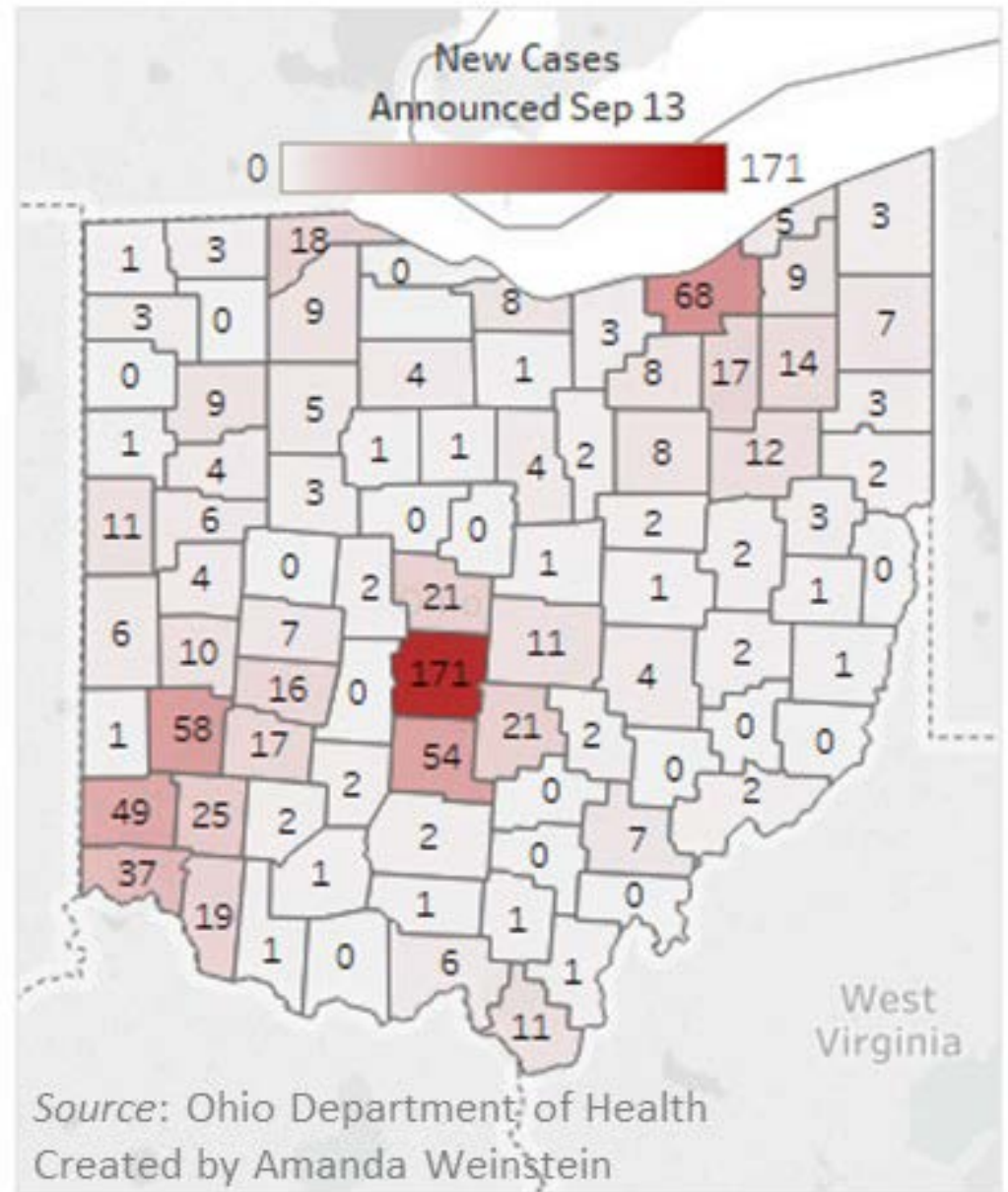
CORONAVIRUS CASES

 3. Miami (968): Butler County

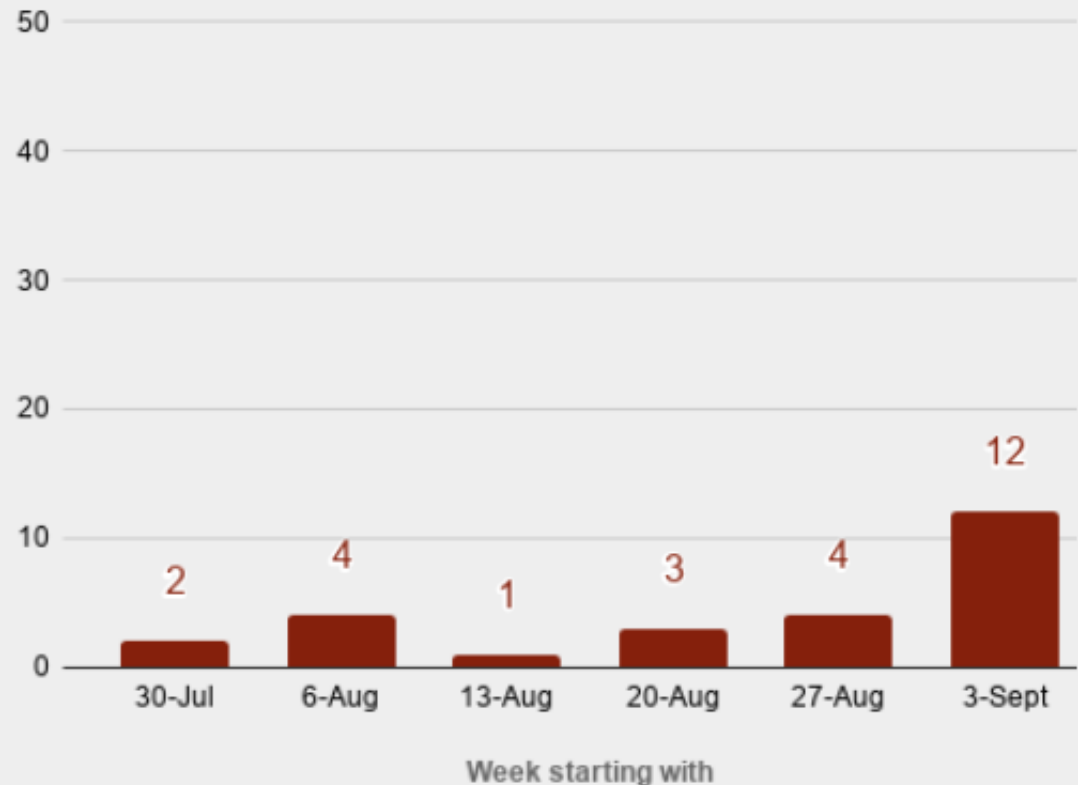

Summit County

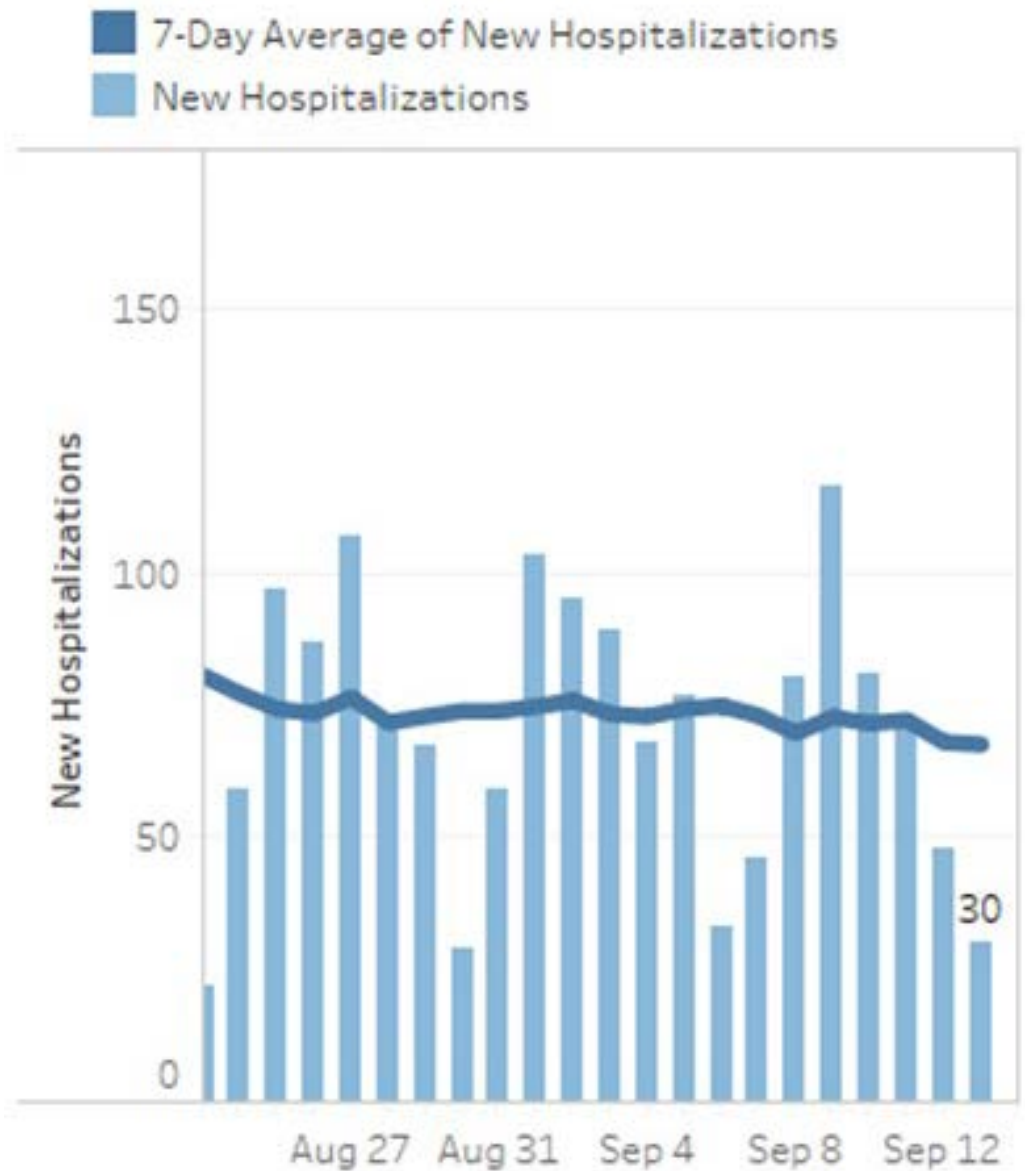
POSITIVE CASES BY WEEK

Figures include students, employees and contractors whose positive test came within 14 days of being on campus.



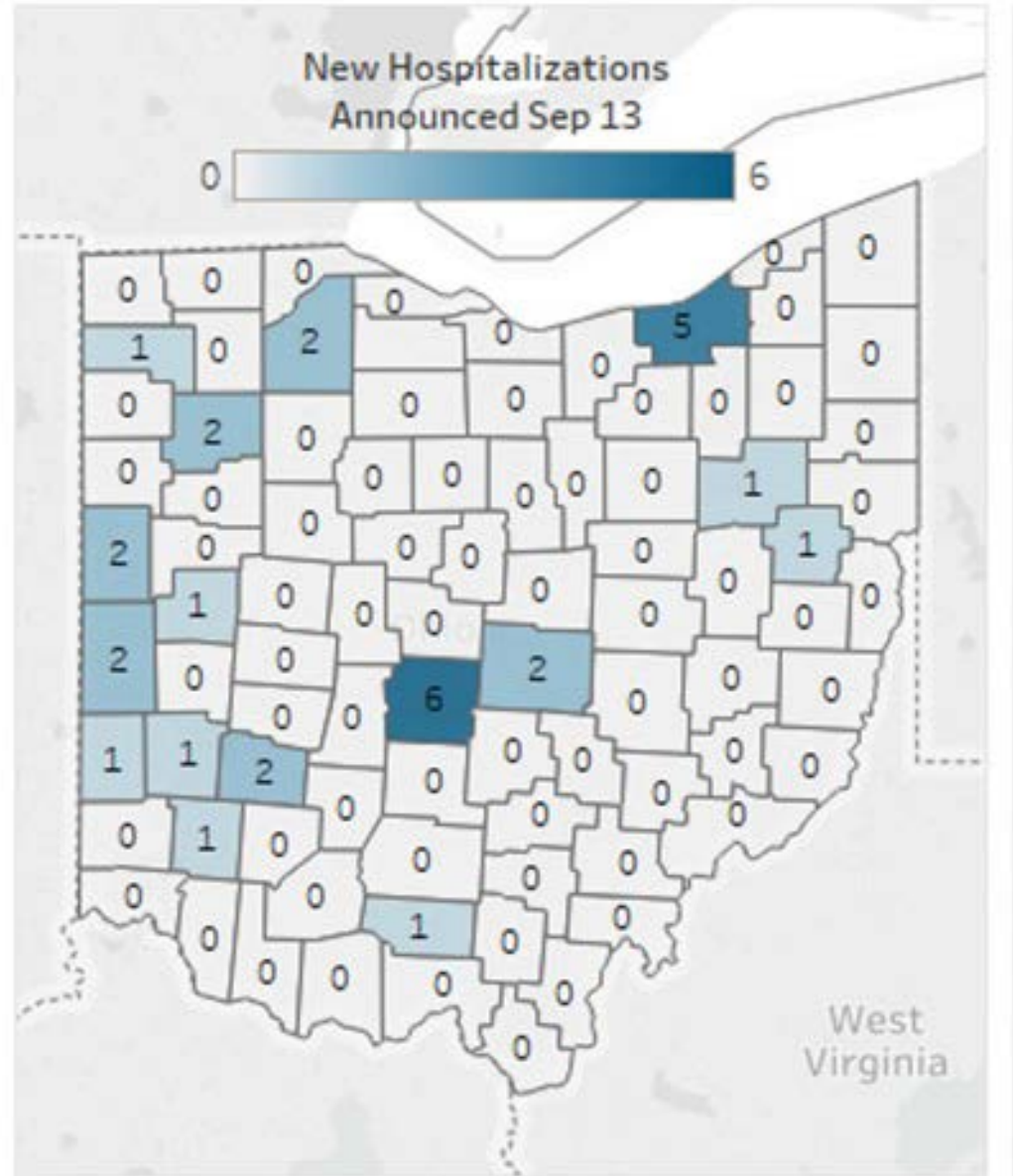
CORONAVIRUS HOSPITALIZATIONS

- 0.6% ↓ in the 7-day average



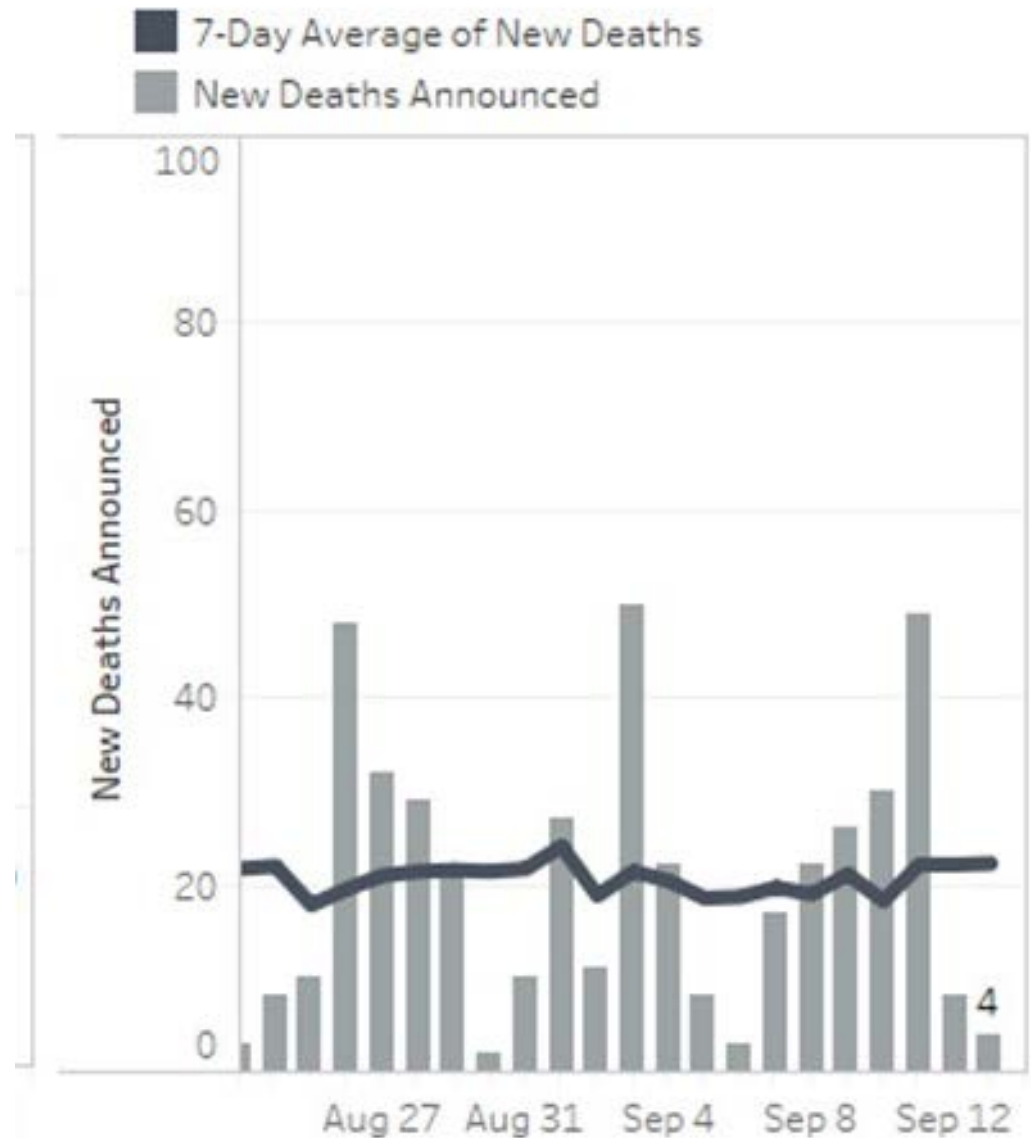
CORONAVIRUS HOSPITALIZATIONS

- Rural areas have less access to hospitals



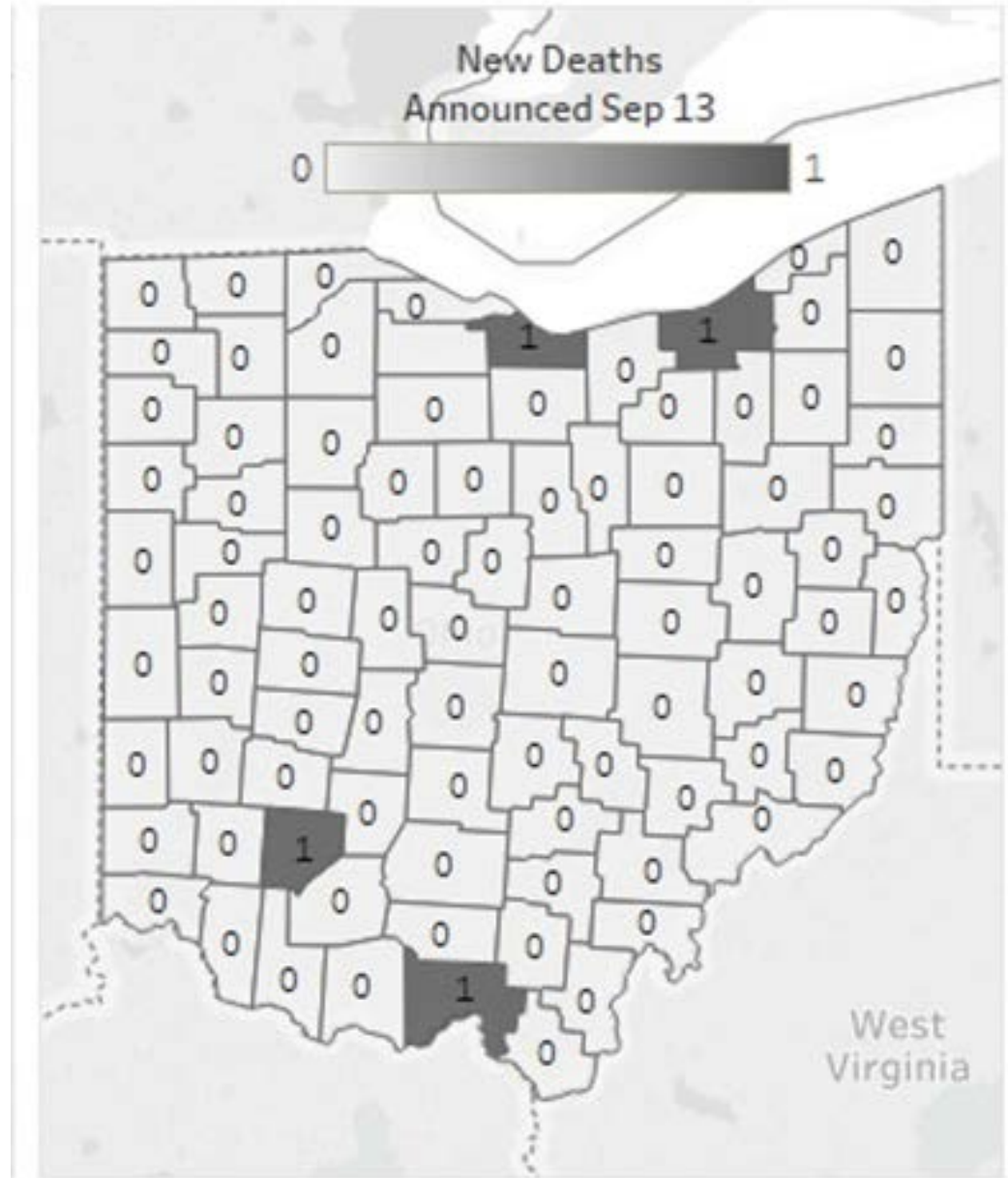
CORONAVIRUS DEATHS

- 0.6% ↑ in the 7-day average



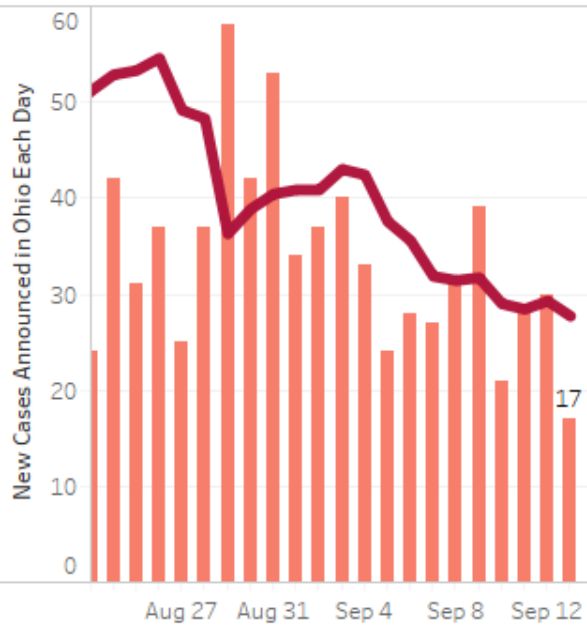

- New deaths announced by county

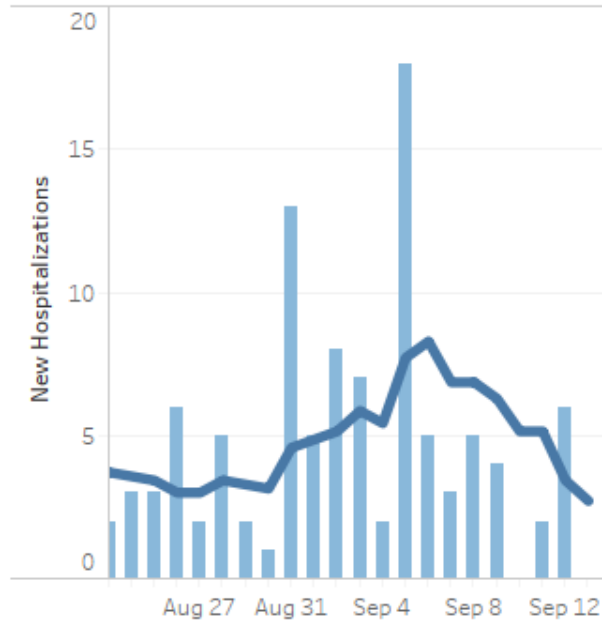

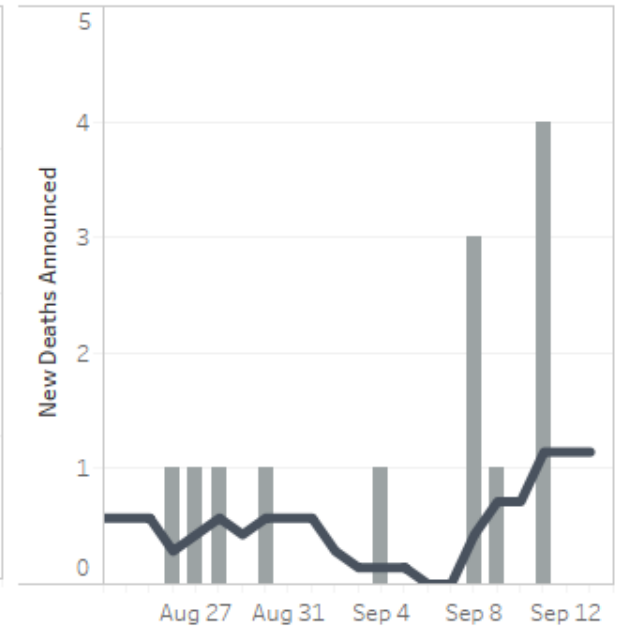

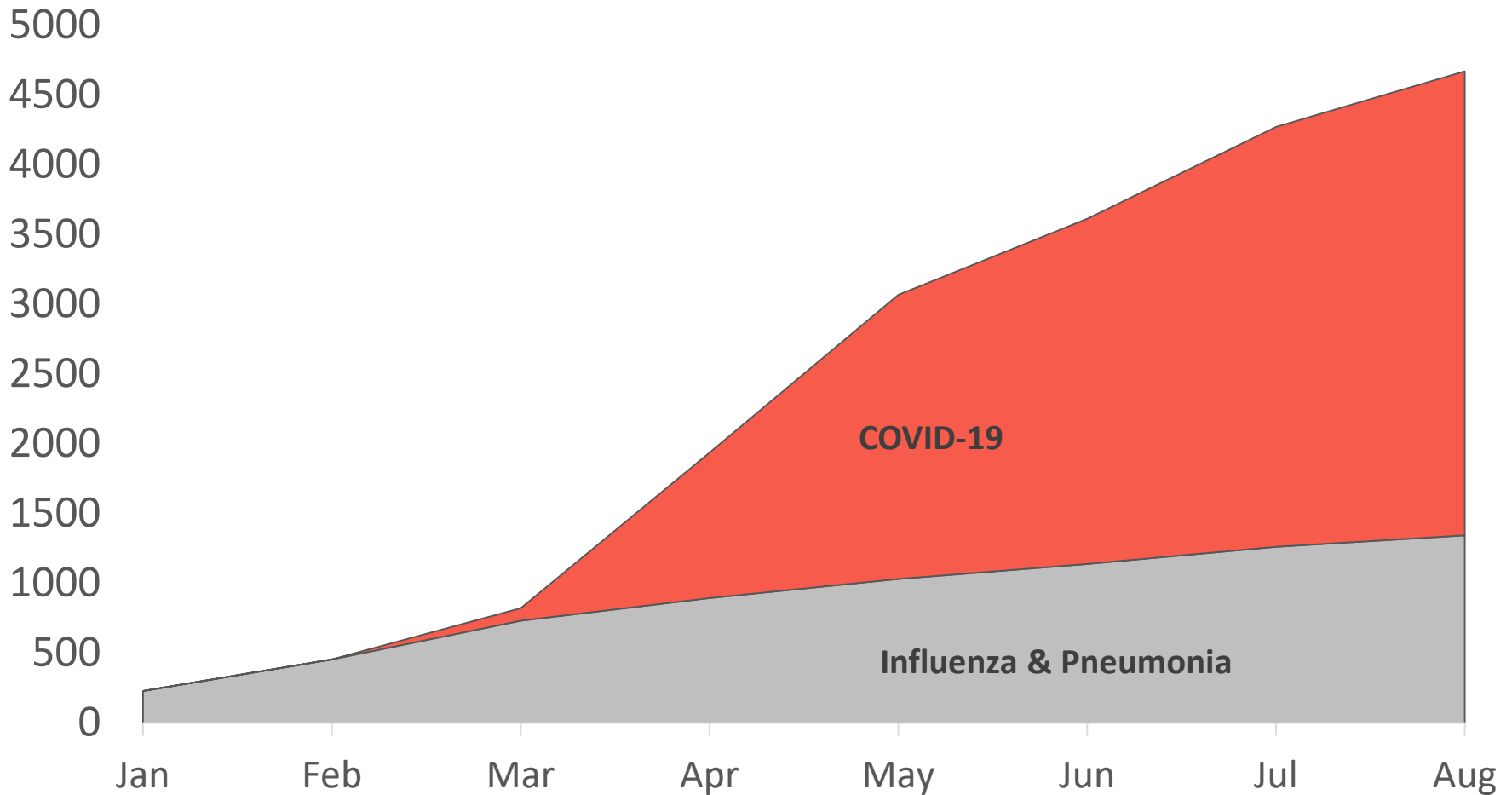

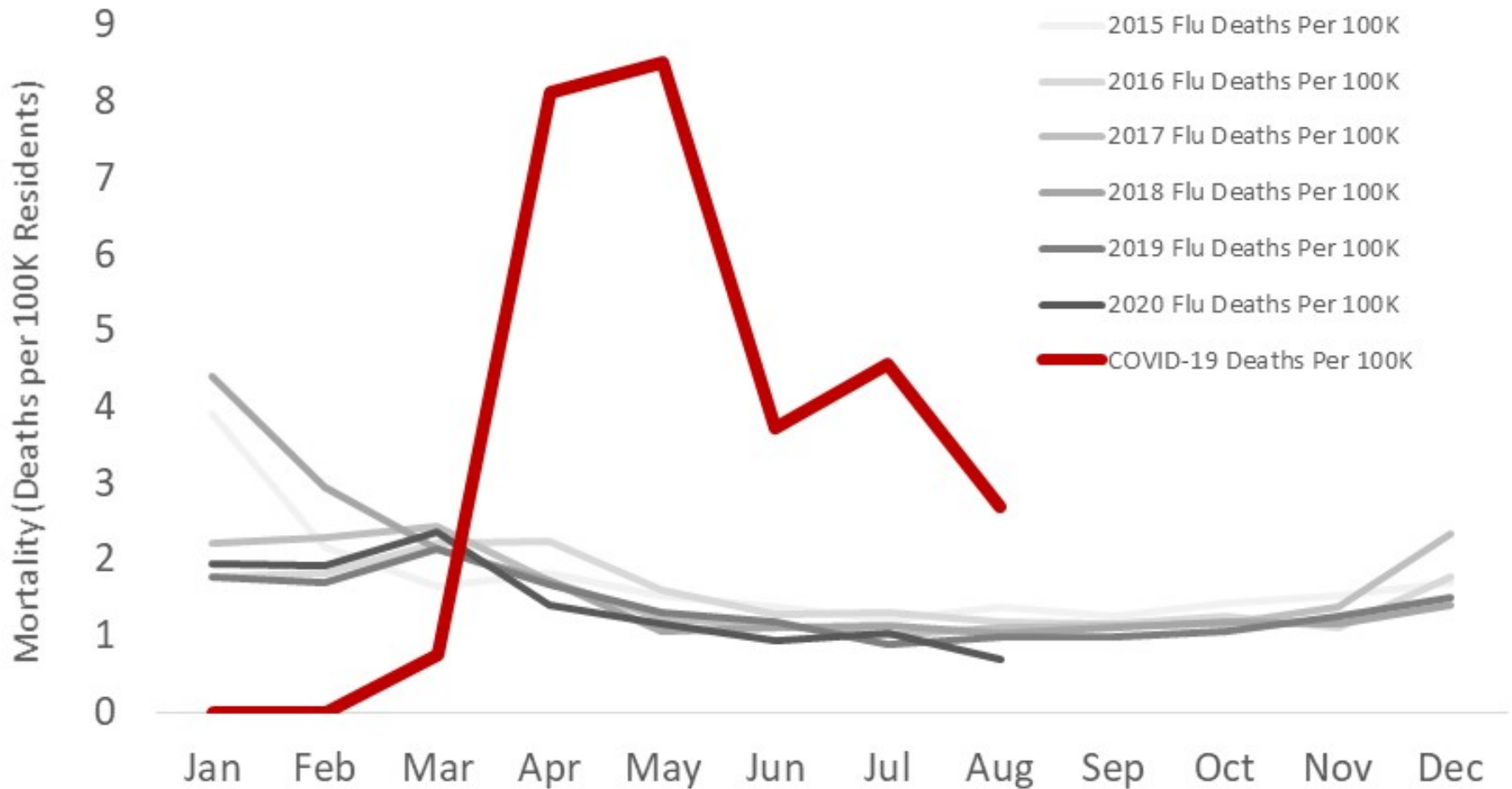
TOTAL DEATHS

Mortality from COVID-19 in Ohio nearly 6 Times Higher than Mortality from Influenza & Pneumonia in April

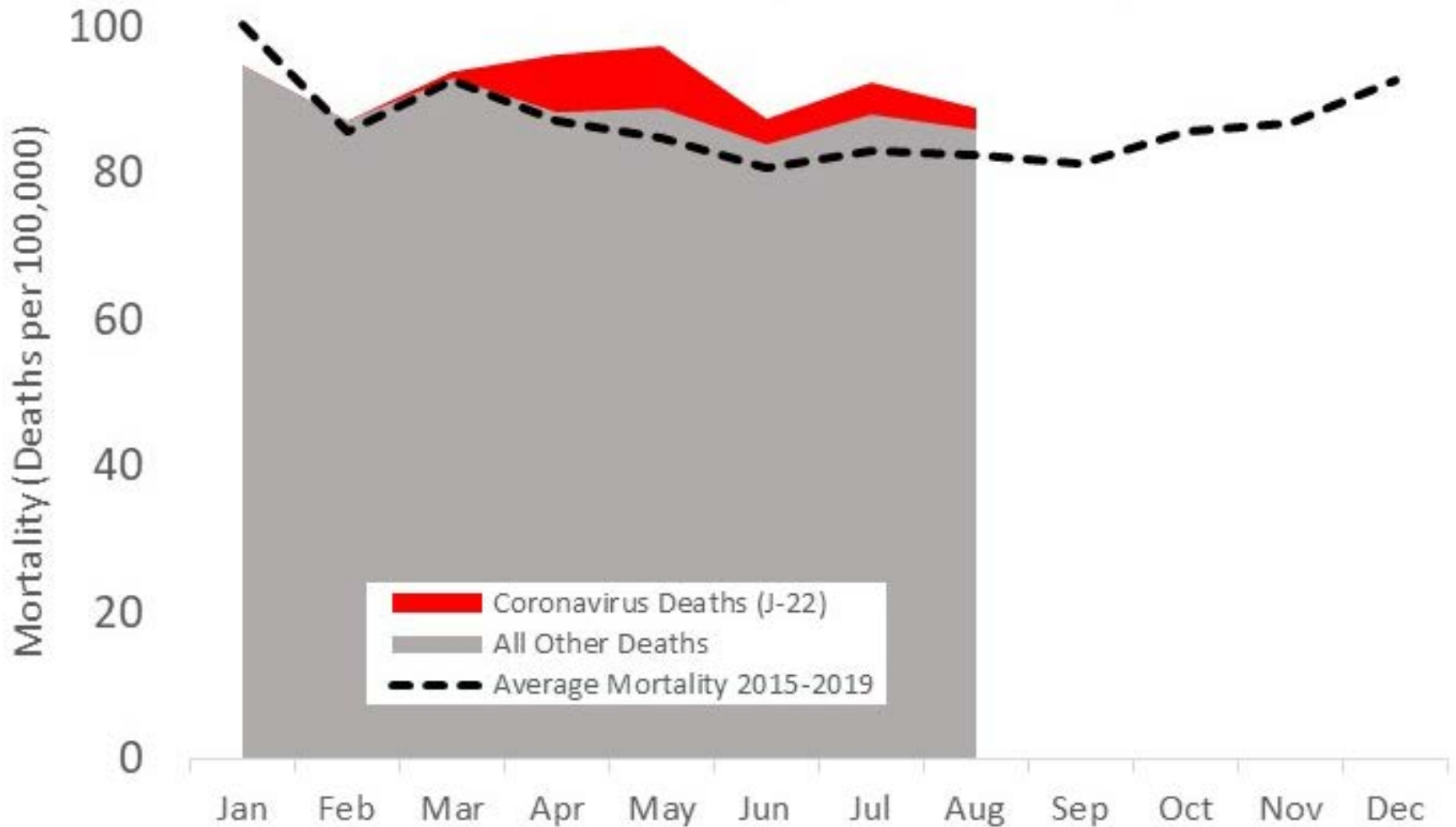

46 additional deaths per 100K March-Aug

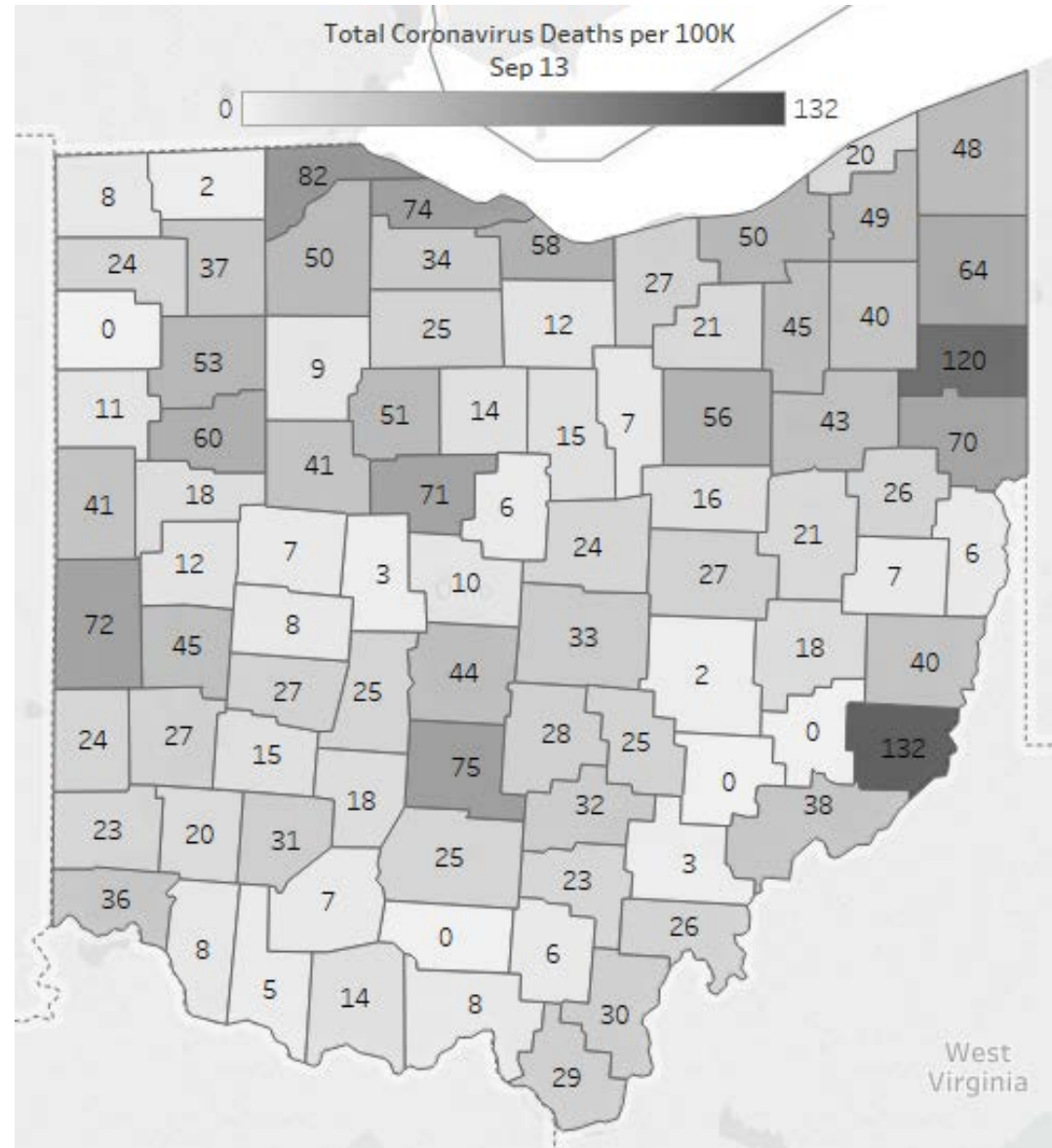

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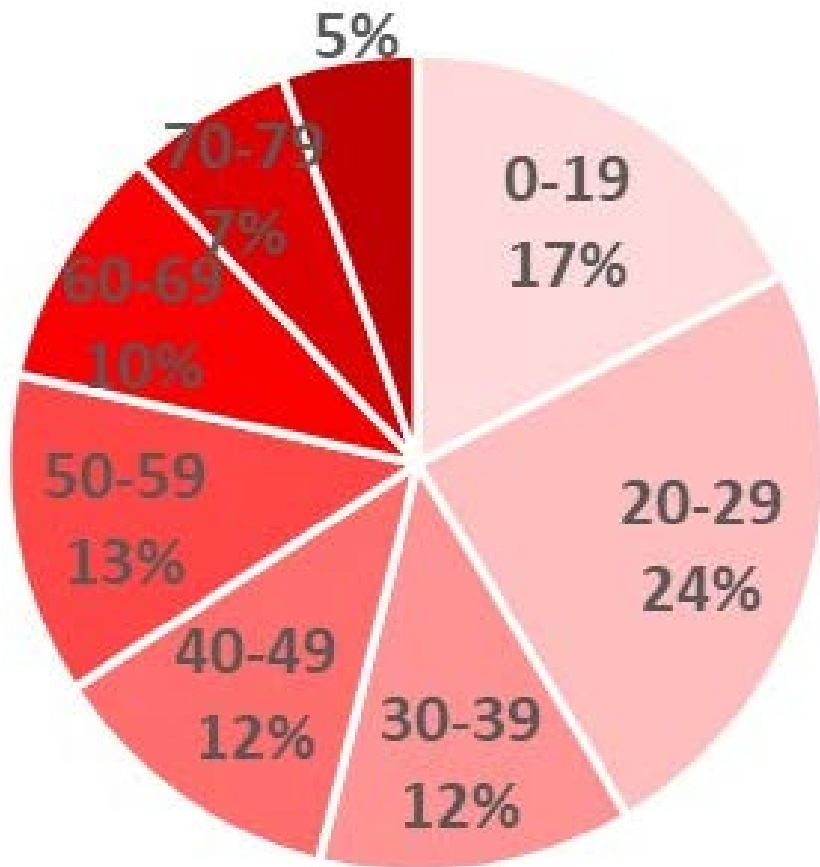
CORONAVIRUS MORTALITY

- Mahoning county (Youngstown) has one of the highest mortality rates in Ohio

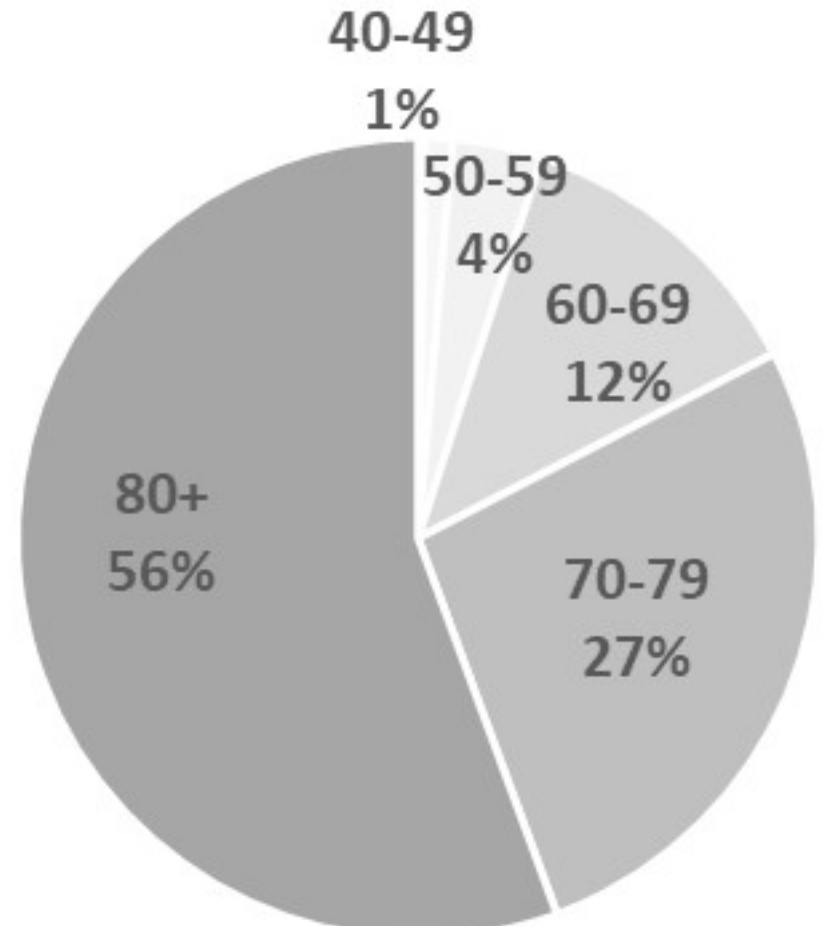


BY AGE

COVID-19 Cases Since August



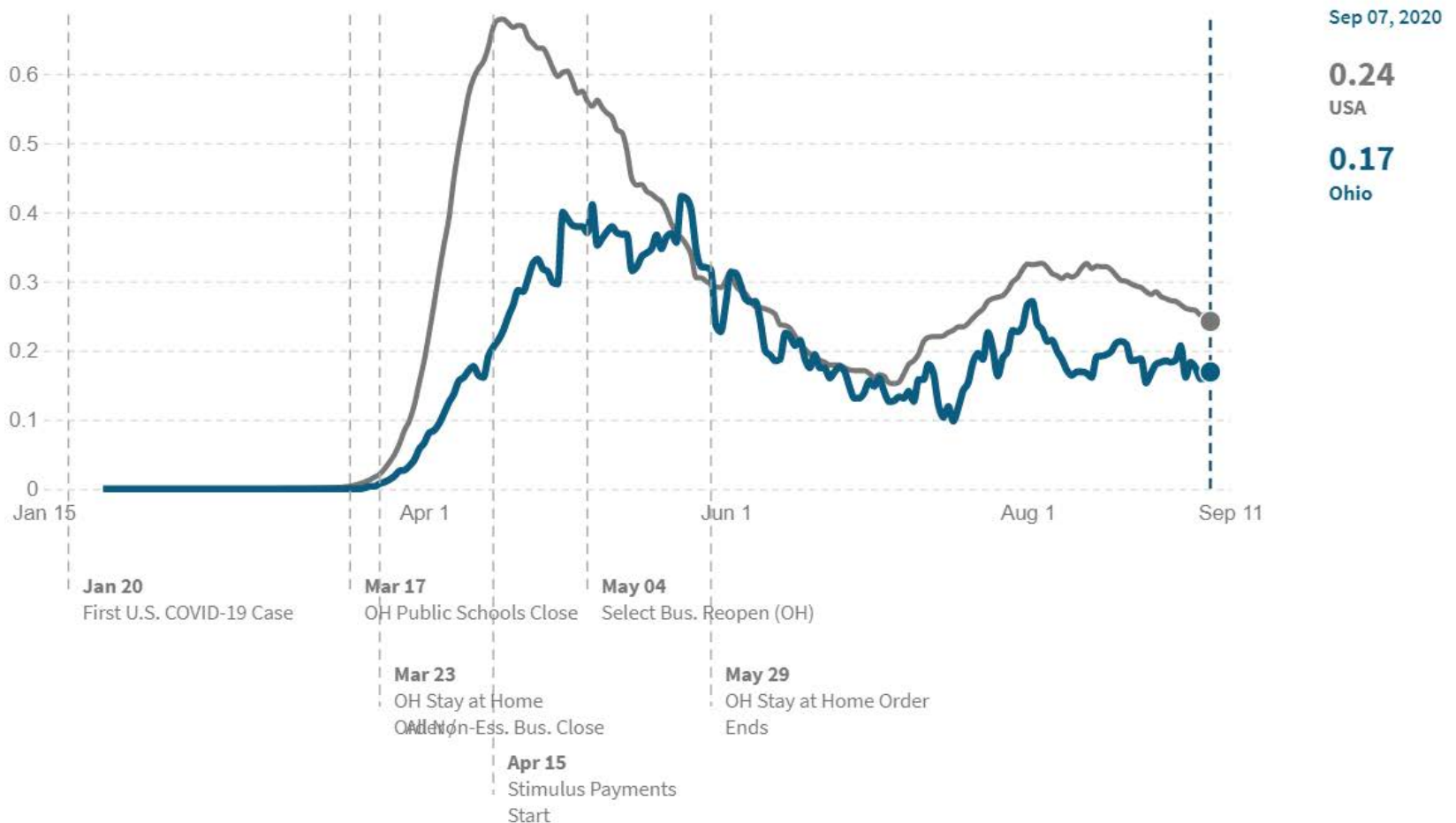
COVID-19 Deaths Since August

Daily Reported COVID-19 Deaths per 100,000 People*

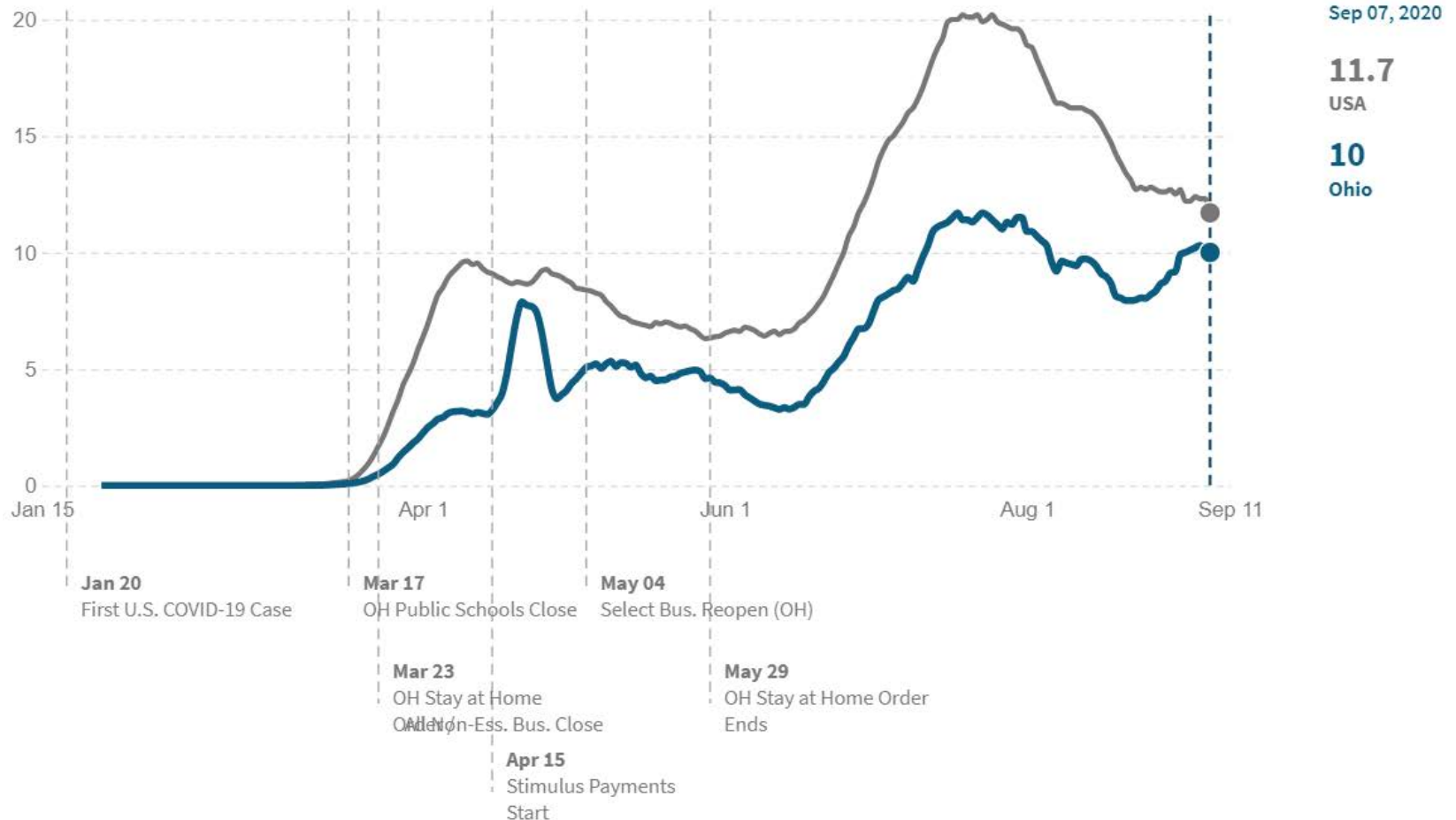
In **Ohio**, on September 07 2020, there were **0.17** newly reported COVID-19 deaths per 100,000 people.

Daily Reported COVID-19 Cases per 100,000 People*

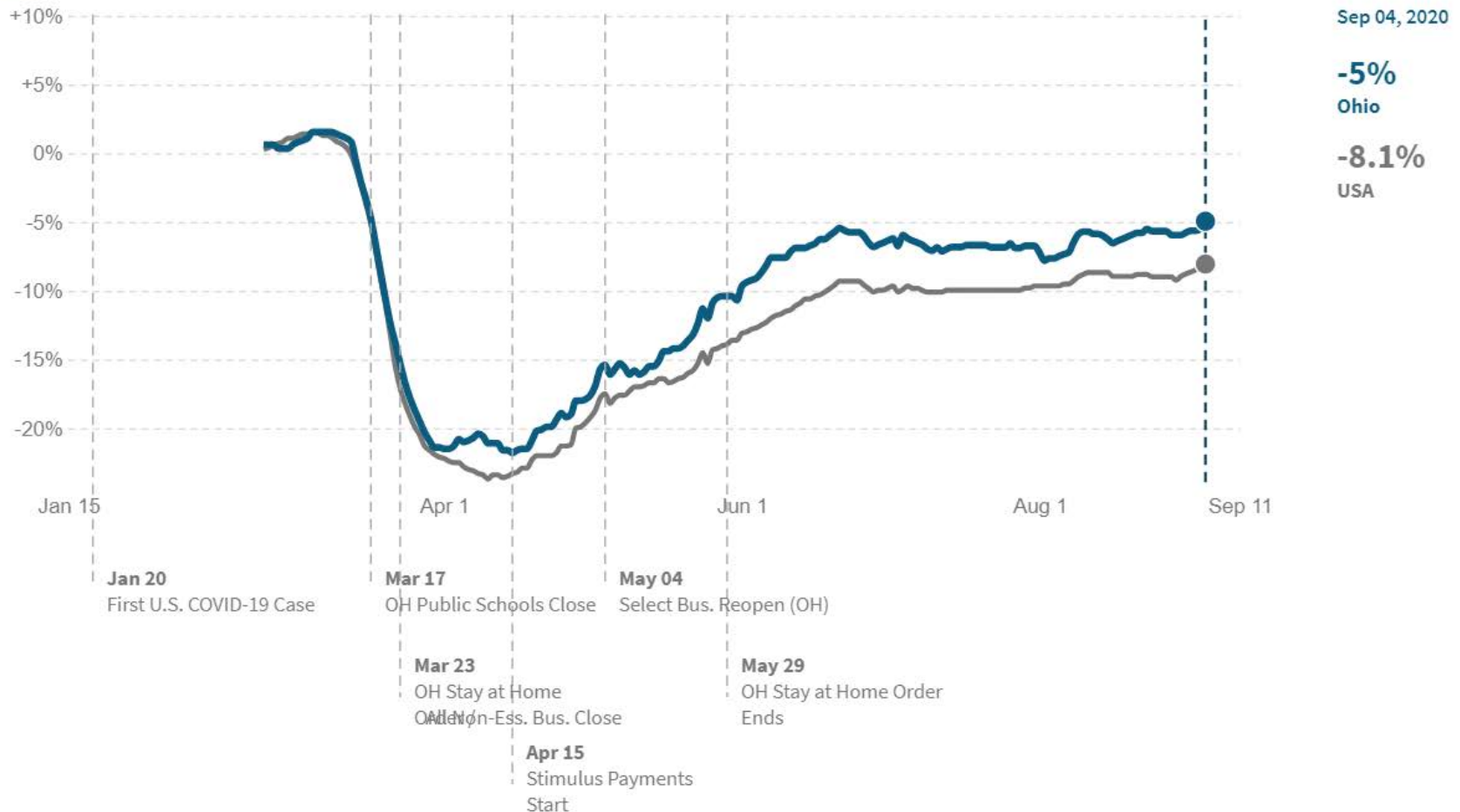
In **Ohio**, on September 07 2020, there were **10** newly reported COVID-19 cases per 100,000 people.

Percent Change in Time Spent Outside Home*

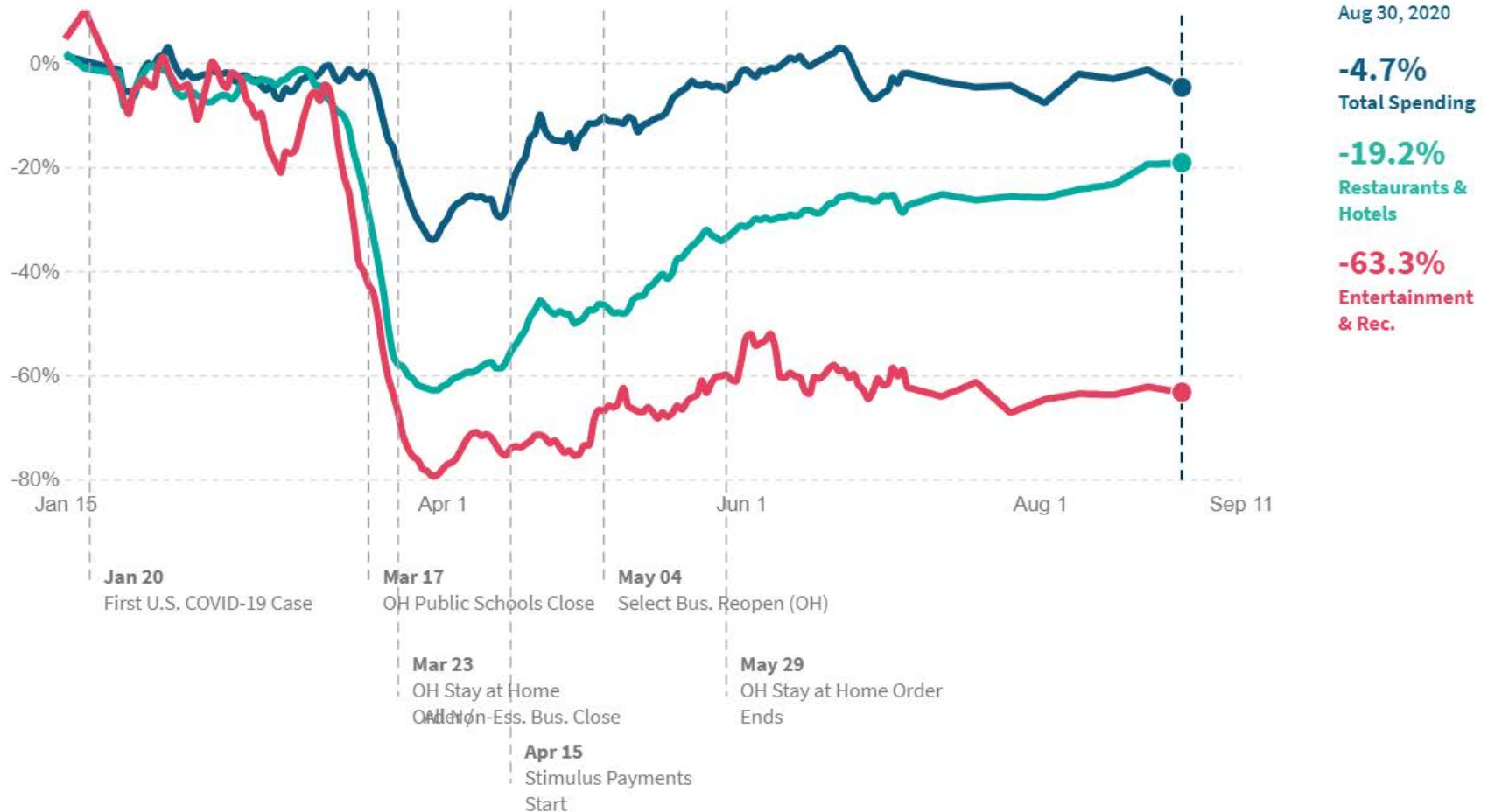
In **Ohio**, as of September 04 2020, total time spent away from home decreased by **5%** compared to January 2020.

Percent Change in All Consumer Spending*

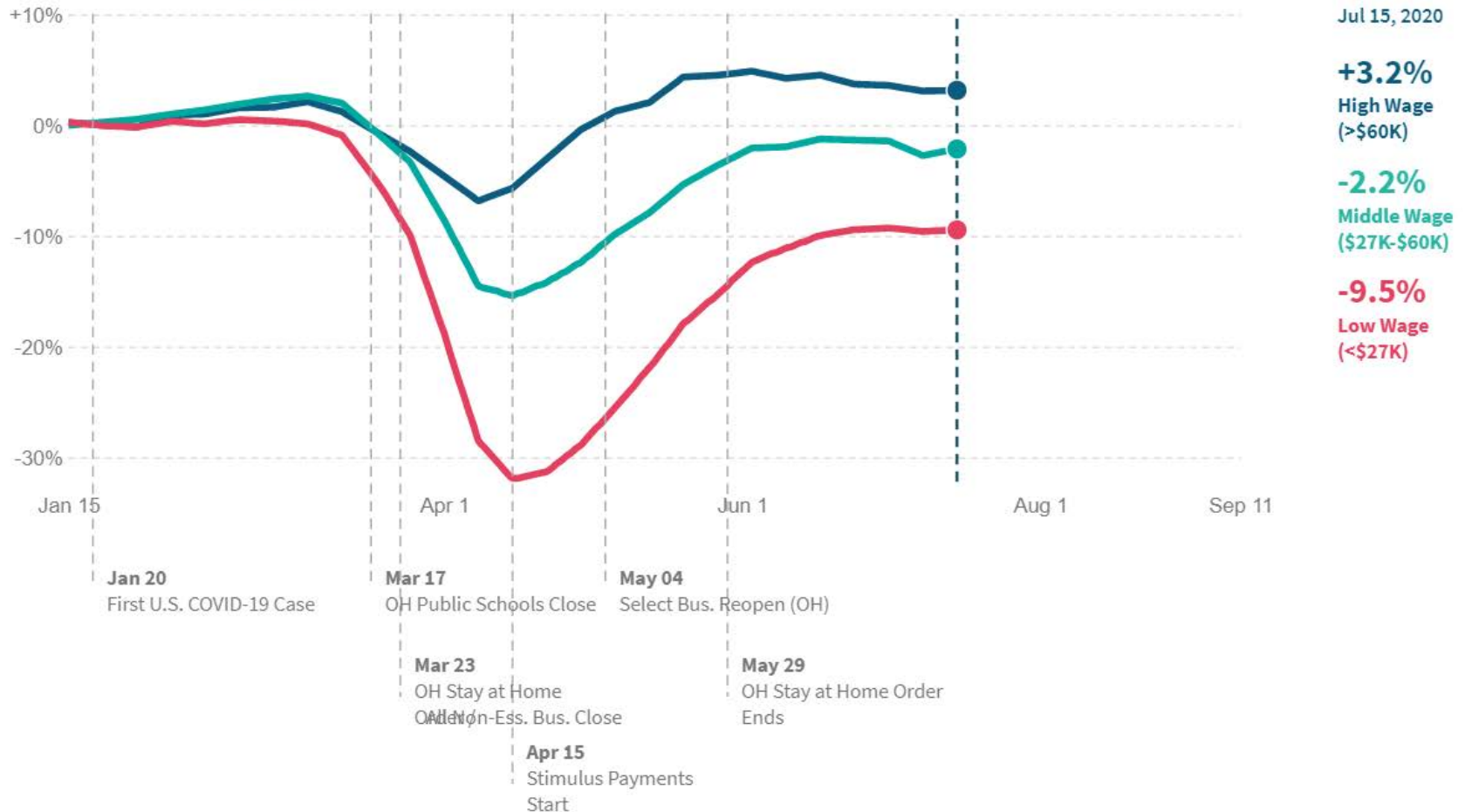
In **Ohio**, as of August 30, 2020, total spending by all consumers decreased by **4.7%** compared to January 2020.



LOWER EMPLOYMENT

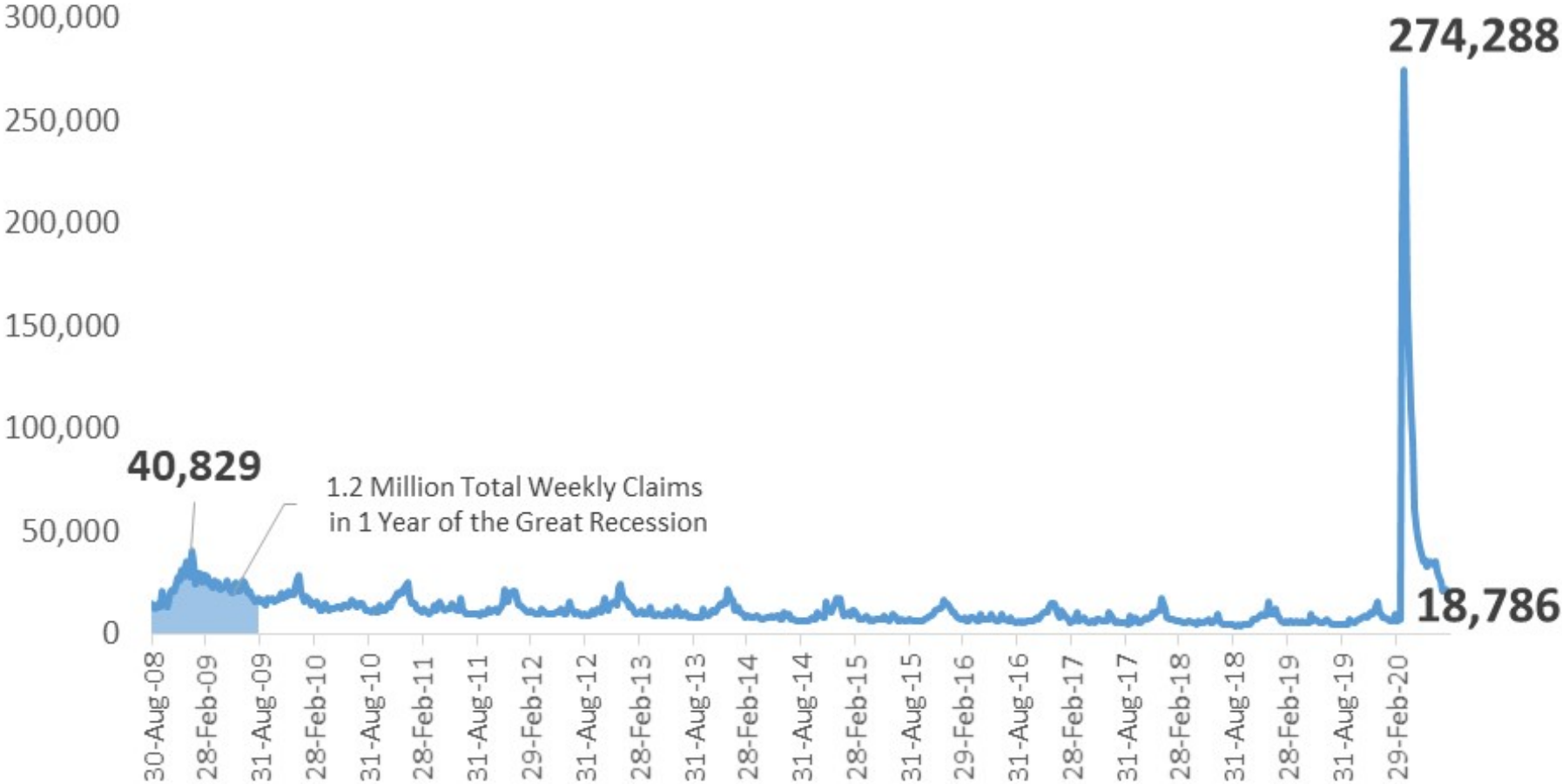
Percent Change in Employment*

In **Ohio**, as of July 15, 2020, employment rates among workers in the top wage quartile increased by **3.2%** compared to January 2020.



WEEKLY UNEMPLOYMENT CLAIMS

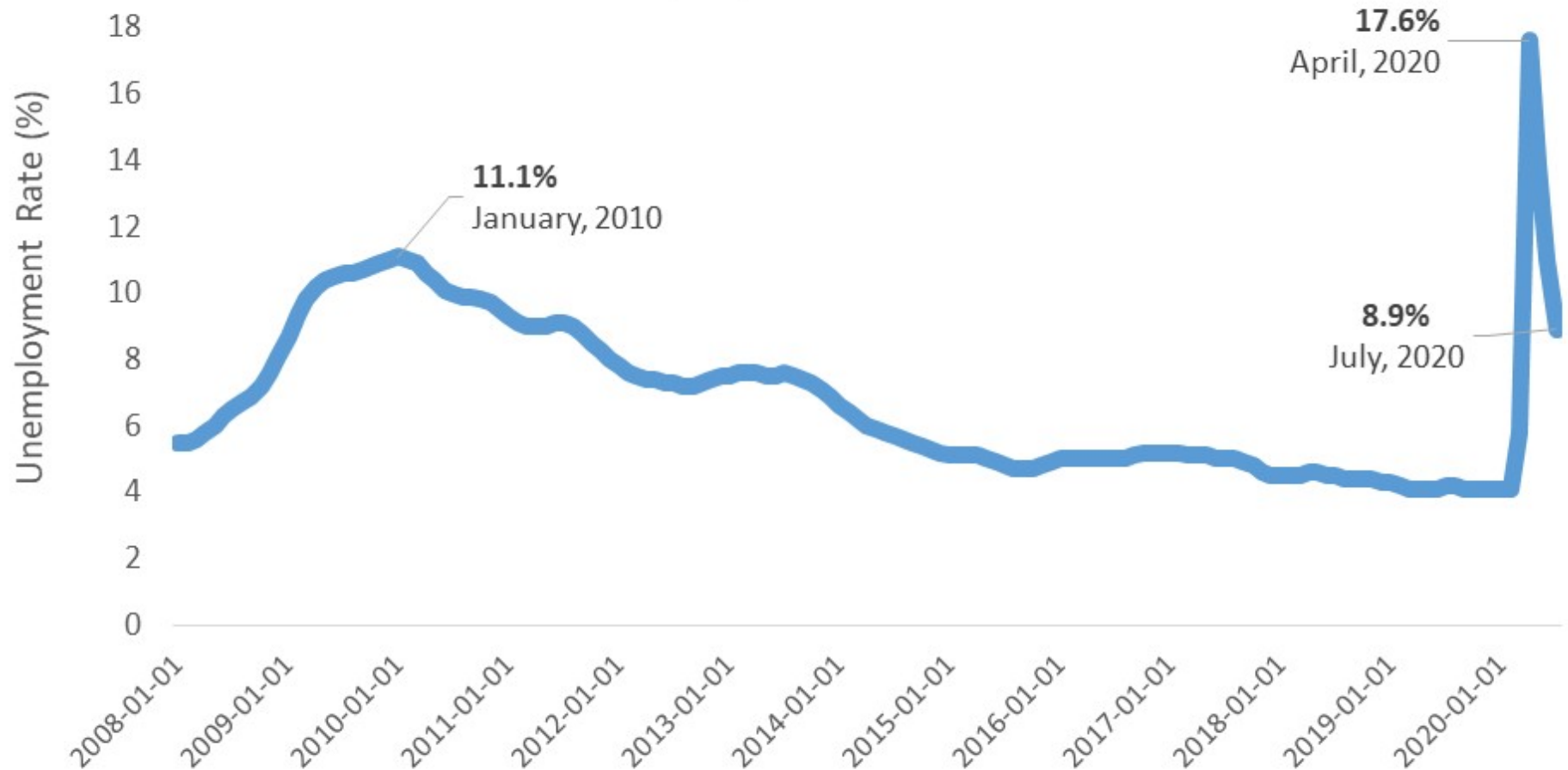
Ohio Weekly Claims for Unemployment Insurance

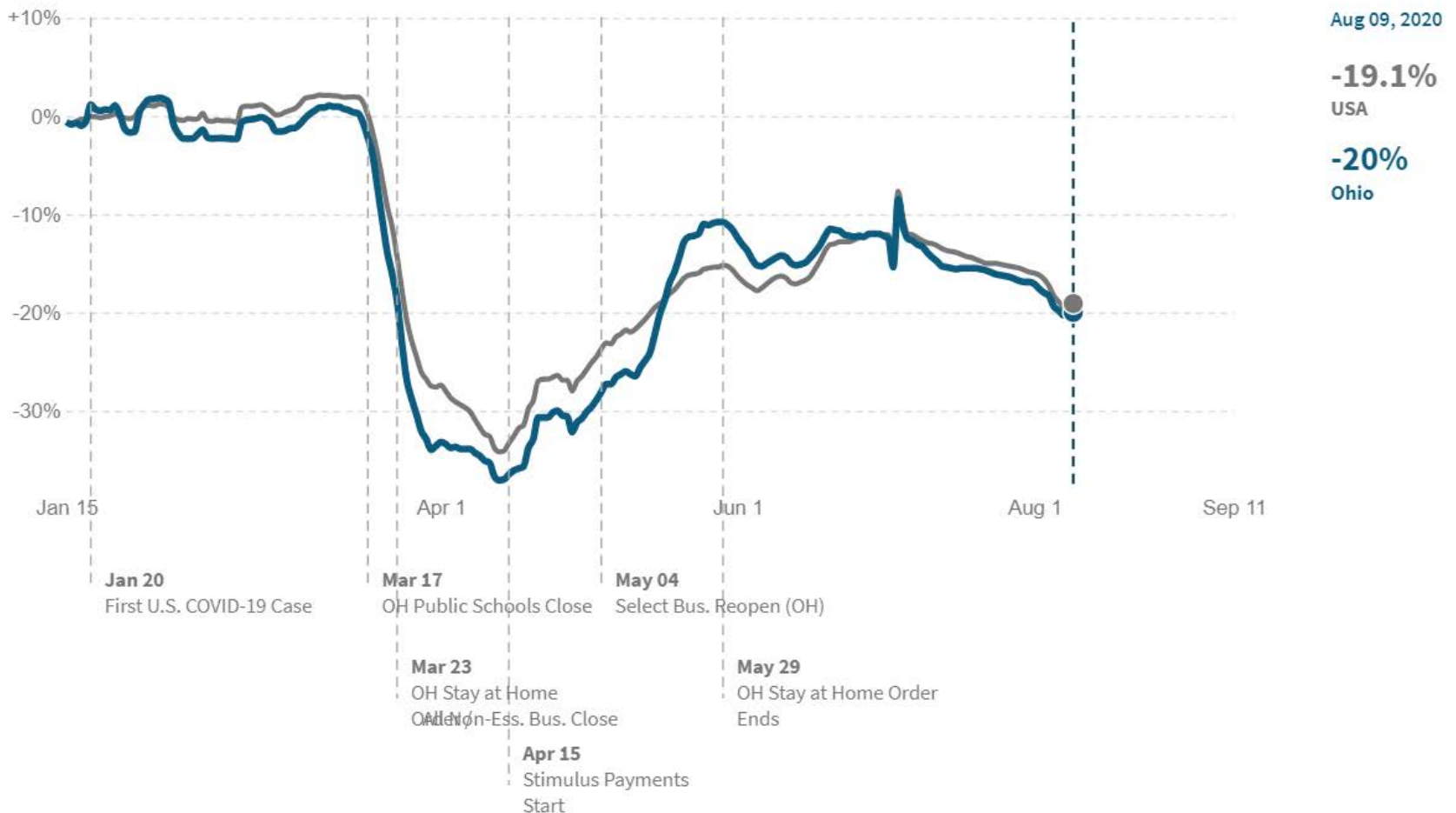
The Unemployment Rate in Ohio



BIG IMPACT ON SMALL BUSINESS

Percent Change in Number of Small Businesses Open*

In **Ohio**, as of August 09 2020, the number of small businesses open decreased by **20%** compared to January 2020.



BIG IMPACT ON EDUCATION

- Recessions usually boost enrollment – not this time (gap year)
- Lower enrollment, trend of declining state funding → lower revenue
- Higher costs (cleaning supplies, hand sanitizer, microphones, ...)

ACADEMIC INSTRUCTION

Course sections



LEGEND

- **Hybrid/in-person** (Some instruction online and some instruction face-to-face. Students must come to campus for hybrid classes.)
- **Remote/online** (Class is fully online or at a remote location, like a nursing clinical. Students do not need to come to campus..)
- **Dual-delivery** (Face-to-face class meetings are streamed via WebEx or Teams, so instruction is simultaneously in person and online live.)
