IP Certificate Course Selection and Planning Worksheet

You need to take 15 credits of IP Courses selected from the courses listed below and earn a 2.3 or higher cumulative GPA in those courses. Courses may not be offered on a regular basis, and you should discuss with your advisor the likely schedule and plan accordingly.

1. General IP Education:

Choose Option A or Option B.

You should learn about as many fields of IP law as you can. Therefore, we require you to take **either** Fundamentals of IP Law (a survey course covering all major forms of IP law) **OR** at least 2 of the 4 core IP courses:
